It just isn't the case." says Steve Durgin, Founder and CEO of Victory For Veterans Foundation, Inc.*

*Mr. Durgin further states, "Suicides are still MORE THAN 22 per day and we don't really know the true number because state laws are not consistent and only about half of our states report these statistics. We need revised legislation so that reporting is consistent and accurate for us to be able to get at the heart of the matter. Additionally, men and women who are 100% disabled are still at 40 - 60% levels - primarily to save money. These men and women gave so much to be treated unfairly is not acceptable."*

*"As a public foundation, we need the public to get involved and stand with us in the fight to protect and serve our Veterans; the very men and women who stood and did the same for us in years' past", concludes Steve Durgin.*
