



## Privacy Policy

We at the Victory For Veterans Foundation (VFV) are committed to your privacy and will follow the following guidelines:

VFV respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal information that you share with us. Generally, you can browse through our website without giving us any information about yourself. When we do need your personal information to provide services that you request or when you choose to provide us with your personal information, this policy describes how we collect and use your personal information.

### Collection of Information

Personal information (“Personal Information”) means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, the following: a first and last name, email address, a home, postal or other physical address, other contact information, title, birth date, gender, occupation, industry, personal interests, and other information when needed to provide a service and/or product you requested.

When you browse our website, you do so anonymously, unless you have previously indicated that you wish VFV to remember your login and password. We don’t collect Personal Information, including your email address. We may log your IP address (the Internet address of your computer) to give us an idea of which part of our website you visit and how much time you spend there. But we do not link your IP address to any Personal Information unless you have logged in to our website. Like many other commercial websites, the VFV’s website may use a standard technology called a “cookie” to collect information about how you use the site.

When Personal Information is collected, we will inform you at the point of collection the purpose for the collection. VFV does not intend to transfer your Personal Information to third parties without your consent.

If you choose to provide us with your Personal Information, we may transfer that information within VFV or to VFV’s third-party service providers, including service providers to provide better services to you.

We will always give you the opportunity to “opt out” of receiving direct marketing or market research information. This means we assume you have given us your consent to collect and use your information in accordance with this Policy unless you take affirmative action to indicate that you do not consent, for instance by clicking or checking the appropriate option or box at the point of collection. In some cases, when applicable, we will provide you with the opportunity to “opt in.” This means we will require your affirmative action to indicate your consent before we use your information for purposes other than the purpose for which it was submitted.



## Cookies and Tracking Technology

A cookie is a small data file that certain websites write to your hard drive when you visit them. A cookie file can contain information such as a user ID that the site uses to track the pages you've visited, but the only Personal Information a cookie can contain is information you supply yourself. A cookie can't read data off your hard disk or read cookie files created by other sites. Some parts of the VFV website use cookies to track user traffic patterns. We do this in order to determine the usefulness of our website information to our users and to see how effective our navigational structure is in helping users reach that information.

If you prefer not to receive cookies while browsing our website, you can set your browser to warn you before accepting cookies and refuse the cookie when your browser alerts you to its presence. You can also refuse all cookies by turning them off in your browser, although you may not be able to take full advantage of the VFV website if you do so. You do not need to have cookies turned on to use/navigate through many parts of our website, except access to certain of VFV web pages requires a login and password.

## Use Of Information Collected

VFV uses information for several general purposes: to fulfill your requests for certain products and services, to personalize your experience on our website, to keep you up to date on the latest information we think you'd like to hear about either from us or from our business partners, and to better understand your needs.

## Information Sharing & Disclosure

Because VFV is a national foundation, your Personal Information may be shared with other VFV offices or VFV Partners. All such entities are governed by this Privacy Policy and/or are bound by the appropriate confidentiality and data transfer agreements.

Your Personal Information is never shared outside VFV without your permission, except under conditions explained below. VFV utilizes web based processing and therefore your information may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country where VFV business partners are located.

VFV may send your Personal Information to other companies or people under any of the following circumstances: when we have your consent to share the information; we need to share your information to provide the product or service you have requested; we need to send the information to companies who work on behalf of VFV to provide a product or service to you (we will only provide those companies the information they need to deliver the service, and they are prohibited from using that information for any other purpose); or we want to keep you up to date on the latest product announcements, or other information we think you'd like to hear about either from us or from our business partners. We will also disclose your Personal Information if required to do so by



law, to enforce our Terms of Use, or in urgent circumstances, to protect personal safety, the public or our websites.

#### Your Ability to Delete Your Account and Information

#### Data Security

Your VFV account information is password-protected for your privacy and security. VFV safeguards the security of the data you send us with physical, electronic, and managerial procedures. In certain areas of our websites, VFV uses industry-standard SSL-encryption to enhance the security of data transmissions. While we strive to protect your Personal Information, we cannot ensure the security of the information you transmit to us, and so we urge you to take every precaution to protect your personal data when you are on the Internet. Change your passwords often, use a combination of letters and numbers, and make sure you use a secure browser.

#### Children and Privacy

Our websites do not target and are not intended to attract children under the age of 18. VFV does not knowingly solicit Personal Information from children under the age of 18 or send them requests for Personal Information.

#### Third-Party Sites

VFV's website contains links to other sites. VFV does not share your Personal Information with those websites and is not responsible for their privacy practices. We encourage you to learn about the privacy policies of those companies.

#### Changes to this Privacy Policy

VFV will amend this policy from time to time. If we make any substantial changes in the way we use your Personal Information we will make that information available by posting a notice on this site.
